Gingerbread Number Line Addition


Materials needed:

- Number line
- Erasable marker
 - Dice (1 to 6)
- Recording sheet and a pencil

How to play:

- 1. Roll the dice and mark that number on the number line with a dot.
- 2. Roll the dice again and hop that number of spaces to find the answer.
 - 3. Record the sum on the worksheet.

4. Repeat.



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
