

## Instructions

- Print and laminate the addition cards for added durability.
  - Grab some erasable markers.
- Count the number of cubes. Write the number of the first color in one box and the number of the second color in the second box.
  - Count how many cubes there are altogether and write the answer.
  - **Extension** Model the sums with connecting cubes. Use two different colors for each sum to model how two numbers (parts) can make up a (whole) number like the picture.
