














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#### Instructions

#### **Preparation**

- Print and laminate the cards for added durability. I store mine in zip lock bags.
- Then put some non-standard measurement units in a basket e.g. counting links, counting bears, paper clips or cubes.

- Place the measuring units along the black line.
- Count how many units long the line is.
- Write the answer in the box using an erasable marker.
